

Fifth Sunday of Easter

My friend and fellow pastor, Father Paul, noticed unsightly, overgrown trees near his parish church. He asked the maintenance crew to cut back the growth, which they happily did, telling him the trees would be much healthier and even fuller after a good pruning. A few days later, Father Paul received a letter from an irate man in the neighborhood who wrote, "Jesus would never prune trees like that. He loves trees, unlike you."

I suspect that the neighbor was not familiar with this week's Gospel in which Jesus says of his Father, "He removes every branch in me that bears no fruit. Every branch that bears fruit he prunes to make it bear more fruit" (John 15:2) I don't mean to pick too much on that fellow. He was perhaps ignorant of

arboriculture. But I'd wager his main confusion was the pruning and removing quality of God's love. That confusion afflicts us all to some degree, doesn't it? It is just so darn easy to react negatively when God cuts something out of our lives and assume it's not his work at all. In the moment, all we see is

the loss, and not the loving desire for future flourishing. The cross is the great pruning of Christ's body. Jesus' rising is the brand-new growth. It is God's promise to us that all the painful pruning in life is leading us somewhere beautiful. What has been cut back or out in your life? A friend, an opportunity, a sense of certainty, a job, health, a relationship? This week, offer those dry branches to the one who lovingly prunes us in order to make our lives burst with verdant growth. *Father John Muir*

THERE IS NOTHING SO GREAT

"There is nothing so great as the Eucharist. If God had something more precious, He would have given it to us." ~ St. Jean Vianney

"Father, do you ever wonder why God did some of the things He has done?" That question has been asked of me many times throughout my nearly forty-two years of priesthood. I can say without hesitation, "Yes, I do. I do wonder."

- I wonder why God made us.
- I wonder why it is so hard to discern His will.
- I wonder if I am doing what God wants of me.
- I also wonder why God gave us His only Son.

Those questions -- and all the questions that you often ask in your own minds -- will not be answered fully until the moment we see God face to face. At that moment, we will no longer care about the questions because we will be in complete union with God and will know all that we often pondered. Until that moment, we search for answers and attempt to do the best we can for our God.

God loves us incredibly. That statement leads us to another question most of us have: Why? We cannot know why God loves us so much; but, He does. He loves us so much that He sent us His only Son. His Son loved us so much that He suffered and died on the cross and rose on the third day to set us free from sin and death.

The night before He died, Jesus, in His great love, gave us His Body and Blood so that we would be able to be nourished while on our journey to the Kingdom. That gift is so very precious and none of us really knows how it comes about.

The Eucharist has also been called the Real Presence since Jesus is present Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity in the consecrated species. The bread is no longer bread; but, His Body. The wine, no longer wine; but, His Blood. As Jesus is truly present in the Eucharist, we reserve the consecrated hosts in the Tabernacle so that people may come to church to visit the Eucharistic Lord.

Every so often, churches place the Eucharist on the altar in exposition so that people may come to adore Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament.

We may not know the answers to the many questions that we would like to ask God; but, we can take time to visit our Lord and thank Him for His deep, abiding love.

FAITH ACTION: God gave us His very best when He gave us Jesus. Jesus gave His very best when He gave us His Body and Blood. What can you give to God this day?
