

In the mid-1940s, Fr. Leo
Hildebrant and Fr. Robert
Weis, both from St. Mary's in
Griffith, recognized the need
to establish a new Catholic
parish in the Munster area. With
determination and faith, they secured
a three-acre plot of land and a loan
from the Diocese of Fort Wayne. Thus, the
first St. Thomas More Church was built and
opened its doors in February of 1946. The
second church and school were opened in 1949
and the third and current church building was
opened in 1969. Over the years, our parish has
grown and flourished, becoming a beacon of
faith and community in our area.

Our church building has been a cornerstone of our parish life, sheltering us during daily and weekend Masses, special liturgies, sacraments, and events. However, as with any structure, time and wear have taken their toll. It has become evident that our roofing systems and skylights are in dire need of replacement. The frequent leaks have also damaged parts of our wooden ceiling. Additionally, the current lighting and sound system does not provide equal illumination and sound distribution throughout the church.

PROJECT

After careful consideration, we have outlined the scope of the project to address these issues:

- Removal of existing clay tiles for salvage
- Removal & replacement of roofing membrane, insulation, and deteriorated materials
- Installation of custom skylights
- Reinstallation of salvaged clay tiles at sloped roof
- Restoration of damaged ceiling sections
- Installation of new wiring for lighting and the sound system
- Installation of new lighting that will diffuse the light in the pews for improved visibility and ambiance creating a welcoming and comfortable atmosphere.
- Installation of a new sound system capable of delivering clear and consistent audio that distributes sound evenly and enhances the worship experience for all

Initial estimates suggest that this project will exceed \$1,400,000. While we have some savings, we are looking to make this our CSA Rebate Project over the next two years. Any CSA donations received over our goal of \$129,414 are returned to STM for a Rebate Project.
